This form shall serve as legal notice that I am exercising my legal rights under 20 U.S.C. section 1232h, and the California Education Code (hereinafter "Ed. Code"), including, but not limited to, sections 221.5, 51100, 51101, 51240, 51500, 51501, 51513, and 51937-51939, and am exempting my herein named child(ren) from objectionable education (including all writings as defined by California Education Code section 250). Pursuant to this notice, you are prohibited from teaching, counseling, instructing, discussing, testing, questioning, surveying, examining, or in any way providing information, images, or data to the herein named child(ren) that is in any way regarding:

- sex education, family life education, health, human sexuality, and sexually explicit language;
- the student's personal beliefs or practices in sex, family life, morality, and religion;
- the student's parents' or guardians' beliefs and practices in sex, family life, morality, and religion;
- sexually transmitted diseases, venereal diseases, HIV/AIDS;
- gender identity, sexual orientation, sexual preference;
- homosexuality, lesbianism, bisexuality, transgender or transsexual issues; or
- any alternatives to monogamous heterosexual marriage

without my express written permission for each and every occurrence.

Further, before any of the above listed topics are in any way presented to the herein named child(ren), please note that I am exercising my rights to: (1) examine all curriculum materials regarding said topics (Ed. Code, § 51101(a)(8)); (2) meet with the presenter and/or principal to discuss the presentation of said topics (Ed. Code, § 51101(a)(2) and (b)(3)(G)); and (3) be informed of all "instruction in comprehensive sexual health education and HIV/AIDS prevention education and research on pupil health behaviors and risks planned for the coming year," pursuant to Ed. Code, § 51938. I also wish to receive information about any and all psychological testing the school does involving the herein named child(ren) prior to its administration. (Ed Code, § 51101(a)(13).) Unless I provide my express written consent otherwise, I am denying all permission to give any such psychological test.

I hereby respectfully request to be notified in writing at least two weeks in advance of all future instruction, activities, events, etc., from which the herein named child(ren) may need to be exempted so that I may provide alternative accommodations for my child(ren)'s education. **This request is made as a direct result of my sincerely-held religious and/or moral beliefs and/or convictions, as well as the individual, developmental, and emotional needs of my child(ren), and the above cited law.** I further request that all of the individuals involved with the education of the herein named child(ren) be notified of this notice, and be made aware of the penalties associated with violating my rights as set forth herein. This form supersedes any prior exemption or authorization you may have on file for the herein named child(ren).
